7. Presentation and discussion on Public Improvement District (PID) financing for the Terrace and the Backyard at Bee Cave.
8. Discuss and consider quotes received for the fencing around the generator and parking lot at the Police Department.
9. Discuss and consider an agreement for the trail extension from Falconhead Boulevard to Bee Cave Parkway including acquisition of access easements.
